## TRIP DETAILS

**Dates:** The field trip will run Tuesday through Thursday, September 10<sup>th</sup>–12<sup>th</sup>.

**Accommodations:** There is a block of 3 double rooms reserved at the Yellowstone River Motel in Gardiner, MT, starting the night of Monday September 9<sup>th</sup> through Wednesday September 11<sup>th</sup> (checkout morning of the 12<sup>th</sup>).

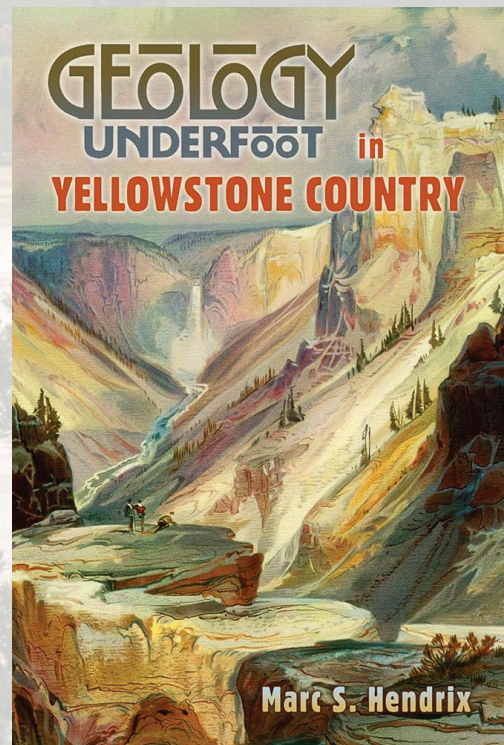
Cost for each room is ~\$200/night, or \$100/night for dual occupancy (\$600 total cost or \$300 total cost if split).

**The first 6 people to RSVP will be given preference for rooms. Any more will need to obtain their own accommodations.**

**Cost:** Free for MGS members, \$50 for non-MGS members (entire trip)

**Daily Travel:** You are welcome to join day-by-day as you like.  
The cost for non-MGS members is \$20/day and free for MGS members.

**Trips will leave promptly at 9 am each day from the Yellowstone River Motel in Gardiner.**
